Design has the power to improve the wellbeing of communities. New this year, DIALOG joins the DesignTO Awards program to introduce three new awards around this foundational idea. The Community Wellbeing Awards identify and celebrate designers whose work has improved the wellbeing of the community it touches, and specifically examines work presented at the DesignTO Festival.

These awards are inspired by the Community Wellbeing Framework that was created by DIALOG along with the Conference Board of Canada to develop a methodology that uses indicators and metrics for the Social, Environmental, Economic, Cultural and Political domains to guide design professionals, project stakeholders, and community members to make design decisions that positively contribute to wellbeing.
